Did you know that some pharmacists provide free treatment to children under the Minor Ailments Scheme (MAS)? Your child must accompany you when you visit the chemist.

Ailments treated under this scheme vary by pharmacy but can include; head lice, temperatures, nasal congestion, coughs and colds, hay fever, diarrhoea, conjunctivitis and dry skin.
